What: Do not make big changes in the South West of your homes this year.

The Chinese New Year (also known as the Spring Festival) is on a different date to us in the West, due to the fact that the Oriental system not only works with the Solar cycle, but also the Lunar calendar as well. The Gregorian calendar which is an internationally accepted one, was devised by an astrologer and doctor Aloysius Lilius. This method of measuring time was decreed by Pope Gregory XIII on the 24th February 1582 and it was this Pope that the calendar was named after. So the Chinese New Year is a combination of our familiar Gregorian calendar and the Lunar cycle and so the New Year is after the second New Moon from the Chinese Winter Solstice.

So what does this actually mean in terms of naming years after animals? How does the Tiger feature so heavily this coming year? The Chinese people attributed certain energies to 12 powerful animals and these animal energies are said to hold the qualities of an element, a time of the day, and time of the year, a position on the compass directions as well as ruling other aspects including influencing a whole year as well. Tiger people are born on particular years, 1914, 1926, 1938, 1950, 1962, 1974, 1986, 1998 and are said to be either at odds or extremely compatible with those that are of different animal signs. For example Tiger people are said to be highly compatible

with Dragons, Dog and Horse personalities for example but in conflict with Rooster and Snake energies.

The Tiger is powerful and daring and makes bold big statements. They can display recklessness and passion but always command respect. The Tiger is the ruler of the hours 3am to 5am, and their direction is East/Northeast.



Tiger rules the season of winter and the month of February and generally holds the energy of Yang which is outgoing and an upward energy.

All this may mean that the year 2010 is a year of big changes and in the light of the credit crisis this hopefully is a good thing.

Sadly with the Tiger on the edge of extinction its Astrological energy may be all that is left of it very soon.
