NATURAL SPRING CLEANING

Harsh chemical cleaners are not only tough on germs, they're tough on you and the environment as well. Look no further than your kitchen cupboards for cheap and effective alternatives like salt, citrus, vinegar, essential oils, and bicarbonate of soda.



KITCHENS

- Lemon and orange essential oils are antibacterial and help cut grease, making them ideal for homemade dishwashing liquid. Mix ten drops of each with 125 ml of unscented natural liquid dishwashing soap and shake well.
- Clean and polish stainless steel by rubbing a thin paste of baking soda and vinegar onto the metal surface. Rinse well with water and dry.
- Bicarbonate of soda removes grease and burnt on stains from pots, pans and other utensils. Flush drains with a solution of boiling water, baking soda and vinegar, followed by a few goes with the plunger.



GLASS

- Mix about 170 ml of water with 90 ml of distilled vinegar in a spray bottle and shake well (you can also add two drops of lemon essential oil to give a nice fragrance). Spray onto surfaces and wipe with a clean, lint-free cloth.



BATHROOMS

- For a bath-cleaning solution, add vinegar or lemon juice to water.
- Borax with tea tree oil banishes mould and mildew from tiles and surfaces. Dissolve 120g of borax in hot water, let cool and add oil. Apply to mildew with a sponge or brush. Let it sit for a few hours and then rinse well with water.
- Borax and lemon juice can clean and deodorise toilet bowls, and help remove mineral deposits. Put 120g of borax and 60ml of lemon juice into the toilet bowl. Let it sit overnight. Next morning, scrub with a toilet brush and flush to rinse.



DUSTING/POLISHING

- Use a mixture of extra virgin oil and fresh lemon will clean wood furniture. Combine two tablespoons of olive oil and two tablespoons of fresh lemon juice in a small glass jar. Shake well and apply to furniture using a soft cotton cloth.

Rising Starlet **Billie Piper** Talks to Star Temple about astrology, parenting, and her latest roles

Billie Piper has crammed a lot into a short space of time. Aged just fifteen, she was a teen pop star with several hit records. At 19 she married Chris Evans, then 35, in a quickie Vegas wedding and six years later divorced him. She then married into an acting dynasty when she tied the knot in a teepee with Laurence Fox on New Years Eve, 2007. Soon after that, the now 16 months old "Winston" arrived. And she's still only twenty seven!

In between all of this she has managed to become one of the UK's hottest actresses, winning awards and a huge following as DrWho's sidekick Rose, and the rather risqué Hannah in *Diary of a Call Girl*.

A look at Billie's natal chart shows a fiery Mars in 9th house Sagittarius; she has an irrepressible taste for adventure. "**I embrace life.**" She says. "I like travelling and I've been exposed to lots of cultures. I don't know if you could say I attack life, I like to get to up and go, to do things rather than talking about them, I like to see new places. I'm very encouraged by life."

We're talking after she has just finished filming her latest project, Kay Mellor's *A Passionate Woman*, a two part film for the BBC. It's the story of a 1950's housewife, Betty – Billie shares the role with Sue Johnston who plays older Betty - who has a mad **passionate affair** with her Polish neighbour Craze (Theo James). Years later on her son's wedding day, the affair comes back to haunt her. It's a film based on Kay Mellor's own mother Dinah, who kept the secret of the affair for 30 years, revealing it one day to Kay over the washing up.

"It was a story I could relate to" Says Billie. "It wasn't too far removed from things that had happened in my family and things that had happened to me lately. I mean like being a **first time mother**, being in a **new marriage** and all that sort of thing."

Billie's character is a typical product of the 1950's: a subservient housewife and stay at home mum. "A chance to play that sort of woman is rare nowadays. Modern women characters are usually feisty and bolshie - not like the women of the 1950s. So it was nice to play a woman of that time really." Her natal chart offers clues as to why this role was a

fit. "I think I am a typical Virgo," Billie adds, "very tidy, very clean and domestic. I'm mean with a mop!"

As a Virgo, born in September 1982, Billie has a tendency to a **compliant nature**. "I'm very passive until something kicks off." She says. A Virgo, especially an actress, will watch how things unfold around them, but once they decide on a role, they'll carry it through meticulously.

Despite the characters she plays, it's clear that the stars had more in mind for Billie than just housework. At first glance, her birth chart doesn't seem to indicate a meteoric career so early

in life. Yet the planets in her chart are in bowl formation, meaning they are all contained in one half of the Zodiac. This often creates the kind of artistic and energetic compression that leads to **sudden career success**. Other aspects, such as Neptune on the Midheaven, suggest vision and magnetism as an entertainer.

Her son Winston is a Libra, a sign that can be idealistic, urbane and charming. Sometimes a Libra will take a bird's eye view of the world, while a Virgo wants to get into

the details and produce a result. The Virgo mum, luckily for Winston, likes to put the child ahead of all else, and is good at making compromises. "We're in interesting times, educational times. It's incredible how children become your life. I can't even remember what it was like before him. And it's only a year and half!"

With a **sexy Scorpio Moon**, Billie needs to stay in tune with her partner. Has baby Winston had an impact on her relationship with Laurence?

"I don't know that has changed us as a couple. There aren't any obvious changes at this stage. What it does have an effect on is work, work load and travelling. If I could work in London the whole time I would be happy!"

Billie is now taking a long break, spending time at her Sussex home with hubby Laurence and baby Winston. "It's been pretty much back-to-back projects for the last few months, so now I'm going to enjoy chilling, walking the dog, Sunday roasts, ah lovely!" If Billie's horoscope has anything to say about it, another run of new projects is not far off!

What makes them sizzle or fizzle?

Some celebrities make a natural astro-match - at least for a while - and it's easy to see what draws them together or ultimately sends them packing. Brad and Angelina for example are, respectively, Sagittarius and Gemini Suns, a famous case of opposites attracting. After all, they got together on the set of *Mr and Mrs Smith*, in which they have it out for each other. Yet, the magic may be at an end.. Conflicting reports of a breakup are inevitable for a couple of this status, with opposing astrological synastry and complex public relations concerns. Alternatively, having two Sun-signs both in the same element makes for a healthy and easy mix. LeAnn Rimes, for example, is a Libra Sun, with Venus in Virgo. But Beyonce's Mars is in Leo, which means she looks for fiery, flamboyant qualities in a man. This planet matches perfectly with Jay-Z's freedom-loving Venus in Sagittarius: astrological chemistry at its absolute best.

Barack and Michelle Obama are Leo and Capricorn Sun respectively and many people have commented on their independent career paths. There is bound to be competition and compromise in such a high-pressure relationship. How do they relax? With a perfect match between his Venus in Cancer and her Venus in Pisces, chemistry is not a problem. Venus is also planet of the arts and they were apparently first drawn together by shared musical tastes.

Good astrology doesn't guarantee love lasting and true, but its principles have stood the test of time. Some challenges between two people's charts are sometimes helpful to keep things interesting, but knowing your personal horoscope lets you see the dynamics of your relationship very clearly - just like the celebrities.

Pampered pooch or fantastic feline - many of us are blessed by sharing our lives with a special and companionable pet, so it is no surprise to discover many traditions have grown up around these creatures over the years. So, as much as you may be glancing adoringly at your furry friend lying beside you as you read this, it really is no coincidence that we have developed such a kinship. Here's a little background on exactly how...

The dog is the animal which has endured longest as a pet and they have many traditions and fables attached to them. Traditionally dogs were associated with the crossing point between worlds, so they were often the companions of the Gods associated with death, such as Hecate. Equally, they were believed to guide and care for the souls of the dead as they passed into the other world.

Mythical dogs were also said to protect the living, for example, in Somerset, in the UK, folklore recounts the story of The Gurt Dog ("Great Dog") a magical canine which protected children who were playing on the nearby Quantock Hills. It also accompanied travelers; acting as a protector and guide.

Reflecting the friendly nature of dogs, in Scotland, it was believed that a strange dog coming to the house meant a new friendship was on the way. Dogs also symbolized the wind and the harvest which chased away famine. This developed more fully in the legend of the Cynocephalus - dog headed man who chased away demons.

Another ancient custom claimed that if someone was bitten by a dog they should take a hair from the creature's coat and lay it on the wound which would then be cured. This may sound rather fanciful, yet the modern notion of "the hair of the dog" as a hangover cure, is a folk-memory from these past times, which is still alive and kicking in the here and now with all its might!

Cats have been with us nearly as long as dogs, the Ancient Egyptians adored cats and they were sacred to no less than three Goddesses; Set, Isis and Bast. In 950 BC Bast became a national deity as well as being the Goddess of joy, dancing and music.

In Japan, Maneki Neko, or "good luck cat," is a beckoning feline that is said to bring good fortune and is very much part of the nation's culture. It is believed to invite wealth, so piggy banks are often created in the shape of the Maneki Neko. The country is still festooned with images and models of Maneki Neko at every turn.

Like dogs, cats have been associated with the weather, and it was said that if a cat sat with its tail towards the fire the weather would change, if it lay with its forehead on the floor or washed behind its ears, rain was likely, whilst if it chased its tail you should expect a storm!

Black cats have a large number of legends surrounding them, originally they seem to have been seen as being unlucky but this was later reversed, so today should you meet a jet black puss on your travels, or if they cross your path, good fortune is likely to follow. Similarly, if you are getting married and a cat deigns to turn up at your wedding, the union should be a highly fortunate one!

When it comes to our four legged friends, science agrees with tradition that having a companion animal can benefit our mental and physical health, so in one way or another connecting with our pets really can bring us good luck. And of course some of us can bond more closely with our loyal furry friend, than we can with often fallible humans! But a well loved pet, looking at us with beautifully trusting eyes, is indeed, a richly rewarding experience for both us and for them!
